- Shepherd change-requests through the change management process
- Perform release management assessment and ensure implementation of the release management strategy
- Support coordination of delivery across multiple teams all on the same delivery cadence
- Work with DevOps team to coordinate and deploy the builds, and work with the QA team to deliver functional code
- Escalate impediments and/or issues that may contribute to delays or missed delivery of commitments
- Support facilitation PI planning readiness - preparation of vision and backlogs

- Ability to facilitate CI/CD builds and enable continuous integration
